

Beginning on June 15 at 9:00 a.m., the City will accept credit or debit card payments online for City utilities (water, sewer, etc.). You may access this payment option by going to the City's website [website](#) and clicking the Online Bill Pay [link](#). Please note there is a \$1.25 convenience charge for this service.

Options to pay with Check via drop off box, US Postal Mail, and directly at City Hall, in addition to cash, debit and credit cards directly paid at City Hall are still available with

no convenience fee.

Please note, credit and debit cards will no longer be taken over the phone beginning July 1, 2016.


In addition to books, movies and periodicals, the Library has several programs for all ages including Story Time, Read to a Dog, computer classes, adult coloring, book discussions, and much more.


Workforce Partnership Mobile Unit @ the Library




Janie Next Door!
